POLICY

Membership in FMCA is not to be restricted in a chartered chapter of FMCA because of race, age, gender, national origin, religion, marital status, or disability.

All chapter members must be FMCA members in good standing. An FMCA member may join more than one chapter.

PROCEDURE

Membership Requirements

- 1. No member shall be denied membership because of race, age, gender, national origin, religion, marital status, or disability.
- 2. An owner of a qualifying family recreational vehicle who is not a member of FMCA is ineligible to join a chapter. However, an applicant for chapter membership who simultaneously presents an application for FMCA membership, together with his or her national enrollment fee and first year's dues, may be admitted to a chapter.
- 3. Any FMCA member in good standing may join a chapter, whose membership is open to new members, provided the member meets the individual chapter's eligibility requirements.

Member Responsibilities

- 1. An individual FMCA member may hold no more than two offices in the same chapter.
- 2. An FMCA member may hold no more than two chapter offices simultaneously.
- 3. A member may hold an office in two chapters; however, he/she may not hold the offices of national director or alternate national director in more than one chapter.
- 4. An individual FMCA member is defined as each adult who, jointly or individually, constitutes a membership.
- 5. At chapter meetings, members should avoid acts or words that might be interpreted as indicating the members were using the meeting to further their personal interests.
- 6. Chapter members are responsible for the welfare and conduct of their guests attending chapter functions.
- 7. Members in attendance should cooperate in carrying out whatever requests are made on behalf of the chapter during its functions.
